

Stuttgart Hohenheimer Strasse Germany



In November 2019, 20 MANN+HUMMEL Filter Cubes II and III went into operation on a 200 metre street section in the heart of Stuttgart. After the effectiveness of the technology had already been proven in 2019 in a pilot project supported by the Baden-Württemberg Ministry of Transport and the city of Stuttgart, the city and country decided to equip additional highly polluted street sections in the state capital with the air pollution control measure.

As the ministry writes in a statement, the "aim [...] is to reduce air pollution of nitrogen oxides in the areas with the highest pollution levels, the so-called hotspots [...]". The ministry continues: "The columns represent a concrete measure for the protection of residents from harmful nitrogen dioxide."
